Proverbs 3:7-8: Trusting in the Lord and turning from evil acts as "healing to your flesh and refreshment to your bones."

June Health focus is Arthritis. It is a broad term for conditions affecting the joints, encompassing over 100 different diseases. It is characterized by the inflammation, swelling, or breakdown of joint cartilage, which leads to pain, stiffness, and reduced range of motion.

There are several types of Arthritis: osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, gout, and psoriatic arthritis.

Symptoms include

- joint pain, tenderness, and stiffness
- Visible swelling in or around a joint
- Redness and warmth of the skin over a joint
- Decreased range of motion or a crackling/ grating sensation "crepitus" when the joint moves

Treatment:

There is no universal cure for arthritis but symptoms can typically be managed through:

- Medications

- Physical therapy
- Lifestyle changes
- Surgery
